The awards and descriptions are listed below. Each alumnae chapter can apply for all four awards; however, a chapter can only receive the maximum of two awards per year. The application consists of a 250 – 500 word response explaining why your chapter has earned the award. Additional documents (photos, fliers, letters of recommendation, etc.) may be submitted as well with your application. We encourage all alumnae chapters to apply for at least one award. Best of luck! The awards will be announced at the Spring Cocktail Event, and the winning chapters will be featured on our website, newsletter, and Facebook page.

AWARDS and descriptions:

1.) Best Collegiate Outreach & Support

This award will go to a chapter with strong programming geared towards building a solid relationship with local collegiate chapter/chapters.

2.) Most Panhellenic Spirit – Chapter Award

This award is for the chapter that participates in other alumnae panhellenic events, co-sponsors programs, embodies the sisterhood spirit of the NYC alumnae panhellenic organization.

3.) Best Philanthropic Program

This award is pretty self-explanatory. The chapter awarded does not necessarily raise the most money for their designated philanthropy, but instead this award includes promotion of the event, creativity, passion, organization, and support.

4.) Best Alumnae Outreach and Support

This award encompasses strong communication, support, recruitment, sisterhood, relationship-building, and event planning within an alumnae group.
